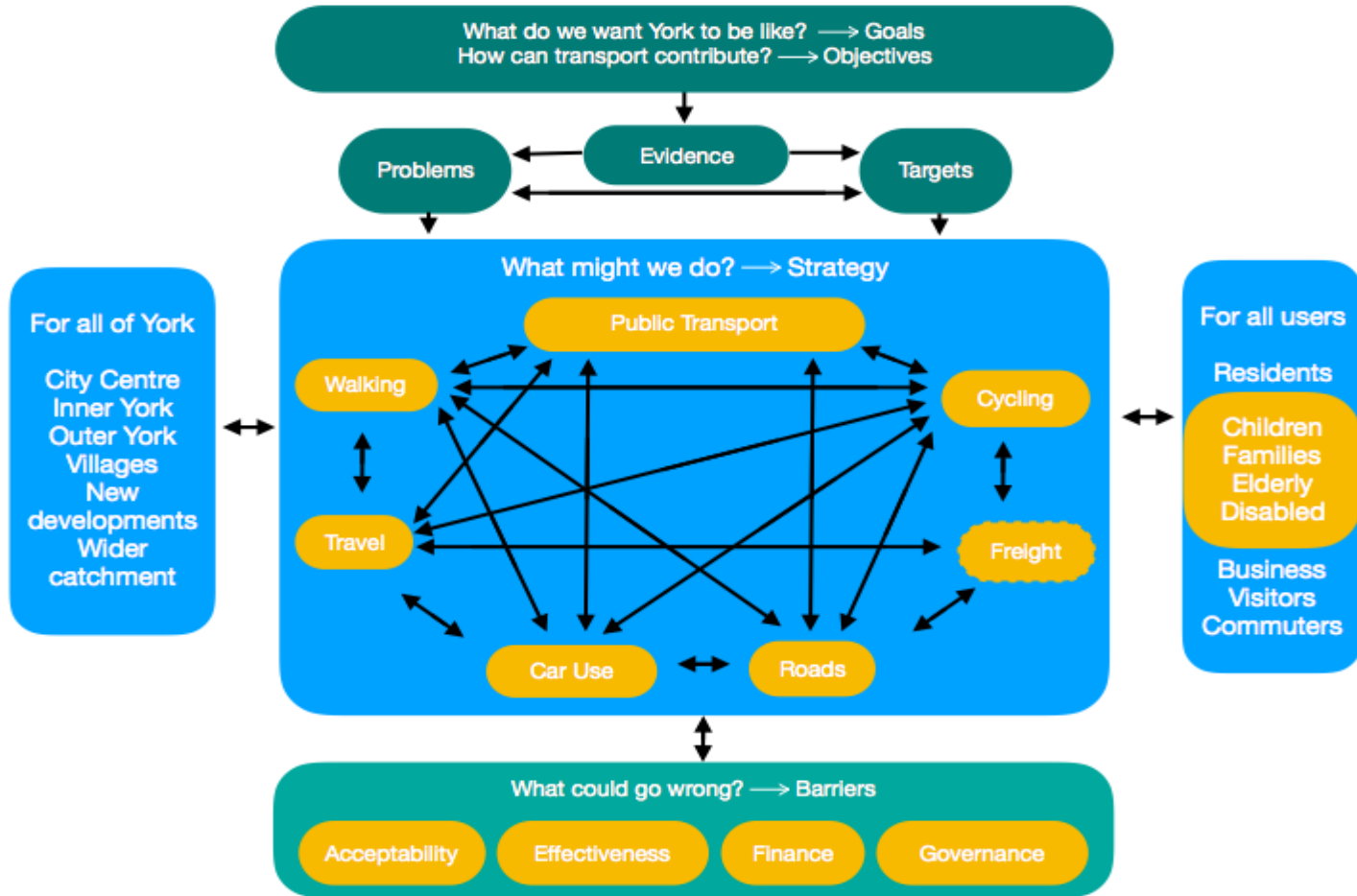

- The YCT Transport Advisory Group: 16 volunteers advising on:
 - Transport planning, traffic management, bus and rail, cycling
 - Town planning, environment, social justice, disability
- With representatives of YBF, YCC, YEF, YDRF, Walk York
 - Initiated the Citizens' Transport Forum (with YBF, YEF)
- YCT/CTF report (Jan 2021) *Towards a Transport Strategy for York*
- A review of LTP3 (2011) and recommendations for LTP4
- Six modal strategy proposals:
 - Public transport, walking, cycling, travel, car use, road network
 - Each with a full 17-20 page report and a two page summary

Our approach



Proposals for enhancing public transport

- A comprehensive review of the bus network
 - To improve access, offer an effective alternative to the car
 - Suggestions include
 - Park and ride sites as access hubs
 - More orbital services
 - Demand-responsive services
- A simple value-for-money fare structure
- Audit of bus stops: access, comfort, real-time information
- Promotion, marketing and Mobility as a Service
- An Enhanced Quality Access Partnership
 - To include operators of other access services
- Innovative funding designed to provide a service to meet needs
